

# CHAPTER 1

## **The Glory of the Woman**

Before one can understand the title of this chapter, one must first grasp why women were situated on this earth.

The first thing that needs to be appreciated is the wonderful fact that a woman's mind is more analytical than that of a man. Most men can only focus on one specific thing at a time, while the woman's mind practically works overtime. This is why women tend to gossip more and why they seem to be fond of chatting. (What's more, women utilize peripheral vision more because of their ability to concentrate on more than one thing at the same moment: for instance, eyeing one man while engaged in a constructive conversation with another individual.) One could say that women's minds have been supernaturally unlocked. It just so happens that this type of diverse thinking is required if one is to be a good mother on this earth. It's not only men who

need the support provided by a woman's analytical mind: children, too, demand guidance and assistance.

A woman's spiritual mind, which is the mind of the human spirit, has more contact with this natural world than does a man's. (This mystery is by and by clarified throughout the course of this writing.) This is what makes her mind so perceptive. What some would refer to as "women's intuition" is simply this vast area of perception. Consider this: If a person contemplates every thought imaginable, it should not seem too surprising if most of the time, she hits the nail right on the head with her assessments. In so doing, she is being sensitive to the subliminal vibes of other people. Using a woman's intuition is similar to taking a multiple-choice test. All of the explanations are provided; it is just up to that certain someone to select the right answer. This explains why femaleness is necessary in a man's life and why it is foolish of a man not to listen whenever a woman may speak and advise him regarding specific areas of his life. It's no wonder that in scripture, the word *wisdom* is often referred to as "her" or as a motherly figure. (Since

*wisdom* is labeled as a woman, should not women be obligated to behave wisely?) This does not mean that women are able to read consciously the thoughts of others, so do not go irritating the pants off someone by claiming to be Miss or Mrs. Telepathic. Spiritualistic and extrasensory episodes will occur, but they will not necessarily be a line upon line reception. Rather, these episodes will be a broad and expansive census, left open to interpretation and assumption.

Because of this distinct quality of her mind, the woman can easily experience paranoia; after all, she has so many thoughts racing through her head. The woman does not only analyze the issue itself; she also examines “the point in question” in every thinkable way, whether in the realm of reason or unreason. This can be exasperating because each of her thoughts seem right to her. As she analyzes each idea, her emotions become involved, which explains why women are easily persuaded to jealousy. As we all know, they do not only observe one side of the mountain: they behold the complete view.

Moreover, the woman's whole pattern of thinking can occur as one big flashback, as she constantly scans and freeze-frames every thought and memory for her own personal self-examination. If we realize that every word that has been spoken and every occurrence that has taken place are like pieces of a jigsaw puzzle just waiting to be pieced together, we will not be surprised that women often take advantage of their investigative minds to resolve unsolved and internal issues. Nevertheless, it is harmful to attempt to read between the lines in order to find something that does not even exist.

You know that there is a problem when you find yourself overanalyzing the simplest analogies that are laid out in casual conversation. When someone presents a comparison, they mean for you to take in the spirit of what they have spoken; they do not intend for you to dissect the technicality of the wording as if examining it under a microscope. Analogies are to be accepted for what they are: **little tangents that are aimed at helping one better understand the main point of a conversation.** Both

the speaker and the listener need to understand this.

I'm not declaring that all over-thinkers need psychological help, since many women face this very issue, but this does explain why there are more hypochondriacs among females than there are among males. What I advise is that if you have this problem, you renew your mind to think soberly. You can do this by learning to accept the fact that some things are just meant to be black and white, simple and true, and by learning to put your trust in others. Illustrations will later be given of when it is appropriate for the mind to wander and investigate those whom you feel are not being trustworthy.

A very subtle but common example of this over-sensitivity is how a woman sometimes reacts when she is walking in front of people she knows are watching her. Being cautious and aware of every step you take, to the degree that you are nearly paranoid about whether you are walking funny, is the result of an observant mind. However, this sort of near paranoia is excusable in the woman, since it is known that specific parts of her are commonly examined by the man. This fact
